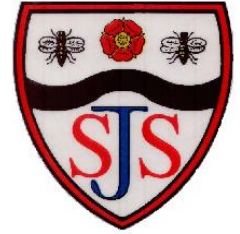

#### Writing

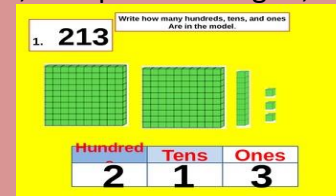
Imagine you want to help someone who is afraid of the dark.

Write a letter or email to them to give them some advice for how they can help make 'dark' situations less scary. Eg.

Have you tried a night light or glow sticks?  
Reflectors on the ceiling?  
A torch/light to carry around with you?

#### Maths

Choose a 2 or 3 digit number. Draw and write as many ways of showing this number as possible. For example you could show it as words, digits, as money, on a number line, as tens and ones, partition it, on a place value grid, as a tally etc.



Can you find 1 more/ 1 less and 10 more/ 10 less than your number?

#### Geography / History

This half term we are learning about Blackburn and the North-West Region.

Research one of the counties in the North-West region (i.e. Lancashire, Cumbria, Greater Manchester, Cheshire or Merseyside) and create a fact file. You could include: population size, largest city and its population, popular tourist attractions, highest and lowest temperatures, rainfall, the main river flowing through the area, highest point.

#### Creative

We are always thinking about being safe online. Create an informative poster with some key messages for how to keep safe online.
