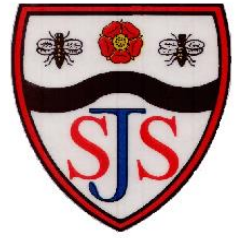

<p><u>Must Do Every Week:</u></p> <p>Read a book of your choice every night for 15 minutes and write a comment in your home reading note book</p> <p>Spend 15 minutes on Times Tables Rock Stars three time a week</p> <p>Learn your weekly spellings given out in class or you can find them on our class pages.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>We will be learning about living things and their habitats.</p> <p>Choose an animal and create a factfile about your chosen animal. Where does it live? What does it look like? What does it eat? When does it sleep? Interesting facts about your animal.</p>
<p><u>Writing</u></p> <p><u>Grammar Practise:</u></p> <p><u>To use inverted commas and other punctuation to indicate speech.</u></p> <p>Write a conversation between two family members from your house.</p> <p>STS</p> <p>New line, new speaker.</p> <p>Speech to begin with opening inverted comma ""</p> <p>First word of speech to begin with a capital letter.</p> <p>End of the speech to have ending punctuation. !?</p> <p>End of speech to have closing inverted commas".</p> <p>Neat, joined handwriting.</p> <p>Use different words for said. E.g. whispered, cried, shouted, bellowed, yelled, replied, answered etc.</p> <p>Ext: Try to include some of your spelling words.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Practise your Timetables on MTC and TT Rock Stars.</p> <p>www.timestables.co.uk is a great website for helping you learn your tables.</p> <p>Learn the 6 and 8 x tables.</p>
