<p>Jesus is given a variety of names to describe his character and purpose.</p> <p>There is a strong connection between Christmas and Easter and the concepts of incarnation and salvation.</p> <p>Christians believe Jesus was/is the Messiah and what that means.</p> <p>Muslims believe that Jesus is one of the five greatest messengers of God.</p> <p>Hindus believe Jesus was a holy man, a wise teacher and a 'god'.</p> <p>Many Buddhists refer to Jesus as an 'enlightened man'.</p> <p>Jews believe Jesus was a teacher and a healer but not the Messiah.</p> <p>People of no faith generally acknowledge that Jesus was a wise, moral teacher.</p>
