<p>Christians believe that through the death and resurrection of Jesus they have the promise of living forever with God (eternal life).</p> <p>Christians believe that when you die your spirit goes to be with God in heaven.</p> <p>Muslims believe that on the last day/the day of judgment the dead will either go to paradise or hell.</p> <p>Hindus and Buddhists believe there is a cycle of life and death, samsara. The spirit of a person is reincarnated and they return to earth until moksha/nirvana (enlightenment) is attained.</p> <p>There are similarities and differences between the funeral traditions in each worldfaith.</p>
