

<p>Not all church buildings are the same but have similar features. Peter and the disciples 'built' the church after the events of Pentecost.</p> <p>Christianity is a world-wide multi-cultural faith.</p> <p>The Bible gives guidance to the church about behaviour and attitudes.</p> <p>World faiths have different places of worship and the names of those buildings, key features and the worship that takes place there.</p> <p>The Hindu murtis (statues) are expressions of god. They are not worshipped. They are a focus to enhance worship.</p> <p>The symbol of light is used across several religions.</p> <p>The features of the places of worship can be linked to Holy Scripture and beliefs.</p> <p>The Imam is the leader of the Mosque and the local Muslim community, the Rabbi is the leader of the Synagogue and Darshan is important to Hindus.</p>
