Year 3 Scheme of Work

Term: Spring 2

Topic: Net and Wall games

Key Skills and Knowledge:

- Stand in a ready position holding racquet correctly
- Move to catch a ball.
- Throw and catch a ball to a partner.
- Control a ball on racket when moving.
- Hit ball across the floor with successfully.
- Hit a ball into a target (with one bounce)
- Tap the ball back and forth to partner.
- Begin to attempt to serve the tennis ball straight from hands.
- Play modified game and score points.
- Begin to recognise how they can improve their score.

Key Knowledge

To begin to recognise that,
 Players cannot carry the ball or catch it with the racquet.
 Players cannot hit the ball twice.
 Players must wait until the ball passes the net before they can return it.
 A player that does not return a live ball in tennis, before it bounces twice, loses the point.
 To become familiar with a racquet and hold it correctly.
 To show the ready positions

| Target practise – in pairs focus on one target, children see how may steps they can take away from the target, aiming to send the ball into it in order to score. | In pairs children stand behind a hoop, their partner must aim to throw into the hoop, bouncing the ball to their partner who catches it. |
