Key Skills and Knowledge:

Dreams and Goals

- I know that sometimes things can go wrong and can tell you why it is good to try again.
- I know how it feels to be disappointed and can tell you ways to stay positive.
- I can plan and set new goals even after a disappointment.
- I can explain what it means to be resilient and to have a positive attitude.
- I can deal with disappointment by analysing what went wrong and I can use these experiences to make new plans to avoid similar obstacles.
- I can explain why being resilient /having a positive attitude contributes to having greater chance of success.

Reading and Writing Opportunities (Long and Short Activities)

Creative Ideas and Hooks

- Learn about Michael Jordan and his dream. Write about their own dream and how it makes them feel.
- Discuss dreams that have been broken or disappointment. Children are to write advice for someone in this situation.
- Role play a situation where someone must reassess their goal to achieve a positive outcome.
- Write a new verse for the jigsaw song to help us be positive when things go wrong.
- Work as a team to make a potato person and hold a competition for the funniest one.
