#### Reading and Writing Opportunities (Long and Short Activities)

##### Creative Ideas and Hooks

- In groups identify those jobs they believe belong to me and those they believe belong to women to open up a discussion on stereotypes. Draw each member of their family and identify 2 jobs they each do.
- Use the solve-it together techniques to resolve conflict scenarios.
- In groups discuss the order of importance of the different online safety rules.
- Discussion on the role of farmers/ labourers/ manufacturers around the world and how they help us.
- Look at pictures of different children and identify what rights the child has been denied. Create a poster to promote children's rights.
- Draw a friend, family member and a child they don't know in another land. Write about why each of them is special to them.

#### Links to PSHCE, Equality and British Values Work

Democracy – They are shown that their choices need not be restricted by their gender, working together to discuss scenarios.

Mutual Respect – Children are taught to respect other genders. Children are taught to resolve conflicts in a respectful manner. Appreciating what people in other lands provide for us.

Individual liberty – Children are taught they can do what they like regardless of their gender.

Tolerance of different beliefs – listening respectfully to other children's ideas. Children are taught to listen to another person's perspective in conflict situations.
